Keynote Speaker: Mr. Philip Mangano

Philip Mangano was nominated in 2007 as one of TIME Magazine's *100 Most Influential People* and in 2008 was recognized by the International Downtown Association (IDA) with a *Lifetime Achievement Award*, IDA's most prestigious award. In 2006 he was recognized with the Rev. Canon Brian S. Kelley Public Servant Award by the Massachusetts Housing and Shelter Alliance, an award which acknowledges a public official who demonstrated leadership in addressing the needs of the poorest. In March 2002 Mr. Mangano was appointed to lead the United States Interagency Council on Homelessness. As Executive Director of the Council, Mr. Mangano has engaged every level of government and the private sector to constellate a National Partnership to end homelessness. The priority of the Council has been to ensure that the Federal commitment to end chronic homelessness achieves realization.
